Engineering work update – Feltham platform lengthening, level crossing closure and cycle footbridge installation

We would like to thank you for your patience during our engineering work over the weekend of 16 and 17 February.

This was the first major stage of the £23 million we are investing in Feltham to upgrade the railway, station and surrounding area to make it safer and more accessible for our passengers and local community. As you may have noticed, we were successful in removing the concrete footbridge adjacent to Feltham West level crossing.

As mentioned in previous correspondence, the upcoming engineering work on Saturday 16 March to Sunday 17 March will involve the permanent closure of the level crossing as well as completing the installation of the temporary footbridge.

What will happen during 16 to 17 March 2019

To cross the railway during our engineering work, we will be diverting the public through the shopping centre bridge. There will be no access across the level crossing. There will be clear signage on our site fencing which will direct you through the diversions.

The diversions are summarised below:

Saturday 16 March 2019 from 21:00hrs	Permanent closure of Feltham West level crossing on Bedfont Lane.
Saturday 16 March 2019 from 21:00hrs to Monday 18 March 05:00hrs	Pedestrians will be diverted through the shopping centre bridge

Passengers for the rail replacement buses will still need to buy a ticket before travelling and proceed through the ticket barriers as normal. Access through Feltham station will be for passengers only.

The equipment we will be using during construction will cause some disturbance, which we apologise for in advance. We will make every effort to keep noise levels to a minimum where possible and our staff are briefed to work responsibly in the local community.

What will happen after 17 March 2019

To cross the railway after our engineering work on the weekend of 16 to 17 March 2019, pedestrians will be able to use the shopping centre bridge or the temporary stepped footbridge we have installed. There will be no vehicle access across the level crossing.
